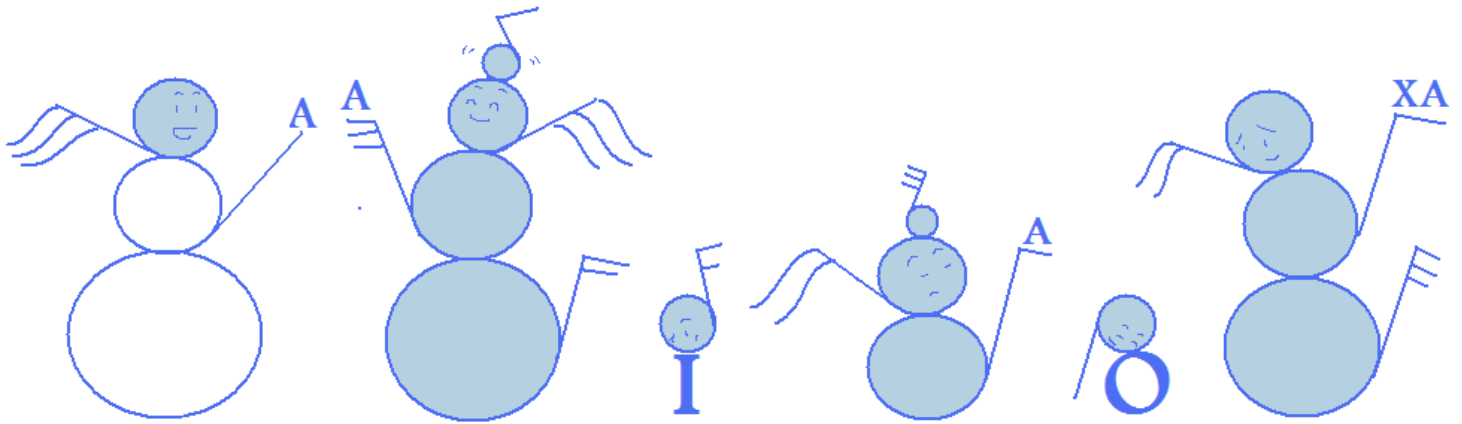


Musical Snowmen

Musical Snowmen Solution

Answer: LOUISIANA

Each part of the snowman corresponds to a musical note. So substitute each of the snowman's parts with the letter that note starts with, remembering to account for the English letters that are also in the picture (i.e. the first snowman's half-note torso is holding the letter "A" to the right, so that part of the word goes "HA" while the second snowman's thirty-second-note body is holding the letter "A" to the left, so that part reads "AT".)

Because snowmen are made starting with the base and ending with the head, that is the order the letters of each snowman should be read.

Altogether, the snowmen read:

what state is east of texas

And that answer is LOUISIANA.
